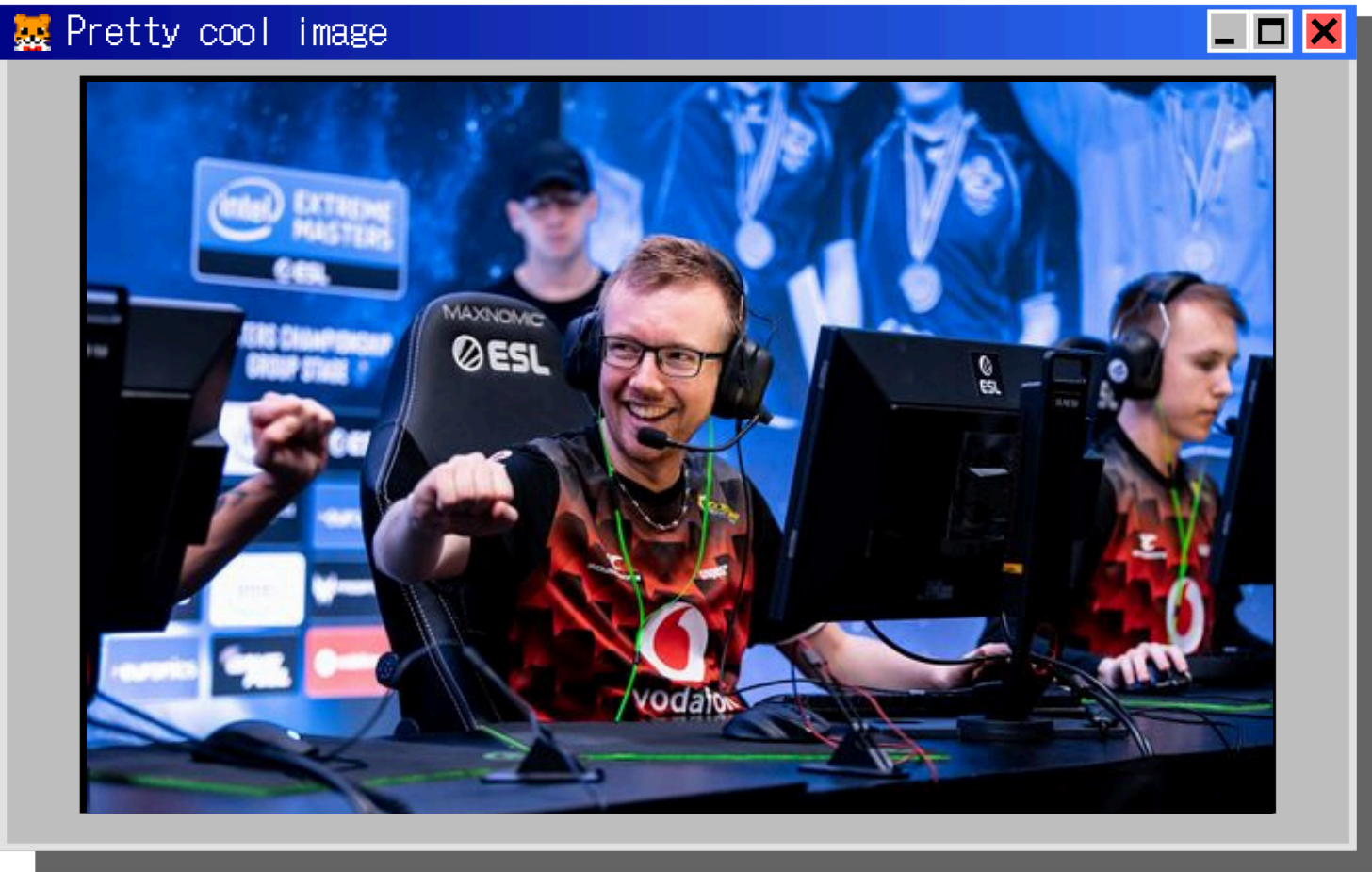




# ChrisJ

Chris “**chrisj**” de Jong (born May 25, 1990) is a retired Dutch professional *Counter-Strike: Global Offensive* and former professional *Counter-Strike* player. He started his professional career in 2012 when he joined e-Sports team Karon3. After switching around for the remainder of 2012 and more than halfway through 2013, De Jong officially joined MOUZ in October.

De Jong became a long-term regular player for the roster. His duties however were switched around for a while. During his time in MOUZ, De Jong has played the roles of: Support, In-game leader (IGL), Main AWP'er and Secondary AWP'er. De Jong's versatility was a strength MOUZ has needed more than once in the time he attended their roster, due to roster gaps.

During the Gfinity LAN in London 2016, MOUZ was able to get to the semi-final of the tournament. After beating opponents like the Polish Virtus.Pro and the French team of EnVyUs, they met the Swedish Ninjas in Pyjamas in the semi's, where they ended up losing.

In late 2018 during the ESL One in New York, De Jong and MOUZ were able to get to the final and faced Team Liquid. With one of the best plays of his career De Jong together with MOUZ were able to defeat Team Liquid. This resulted in 125,000 prize money for MOUZ.

After a defeat during the IEM Katowice Major tournament later in 2018/early 2019, De Jong was benched. Although the team had been performing reasonably well, and were even by some reports considered to be on the verge of "title contention" status, the organisation brought three new players into the roster.

A little less than 3 months later, in May 2019 MOUZ revealed that De Jong would again be part of their active roster.

Later that year De Jong was able to win two big tournaments together with his team, de Asia Championships and the ESL Pro League Season 10. He also won a smaller prize that year by taking first place at the CS Summit 5. The same year his team took second place in the final of Epicenter, losing 1-2 to Team Vitality in the final.

In 2020 De Jong and his team were able to get first place during the Ice Challenge.

In January 2021, De Jong was benched again, and loaned to FunPlus Phoenix, for whom he played from early 2021 till January 2022, after which he officially departed from MOUZ.
